
# **ESCB - ONE MINUTE GUIDE**

- Police












These Safeguarding Partners have joint and equal duties and responsibilities to ensure:

- That agencies work together to safeguard and promote the welfare of all children across Essex.
- Include and develop the role of wider local organisations and agencies in the process.
- They have a clear line of sight in relation to the key and critical safeguarding issues across Essex.

The Lead Safeguarding Partners each nominate a Delegated Safeguarding Partner from their organisation. Details of these can be found in the MASA Plan 2024-2025.

### Structure of the ESCB



The work of the Board is carried out by the **sub**committees, stay safe groups and task and finish groups.

The ESCB does not take safeguarding referrals. If you have a concern about the welfare of a child, contact the Children and Families Hub.

### **Child Safeguarding Practice Reviews (CSPR)**

Reviews help the safeguarding system identify how it can work together better to safeguard children in Essex.

The purpose of a CSPR is to look at the involvement that organisations and professionals have had with a particular family or child. A CSPR is a review about learning and NOT about fault or blame.
